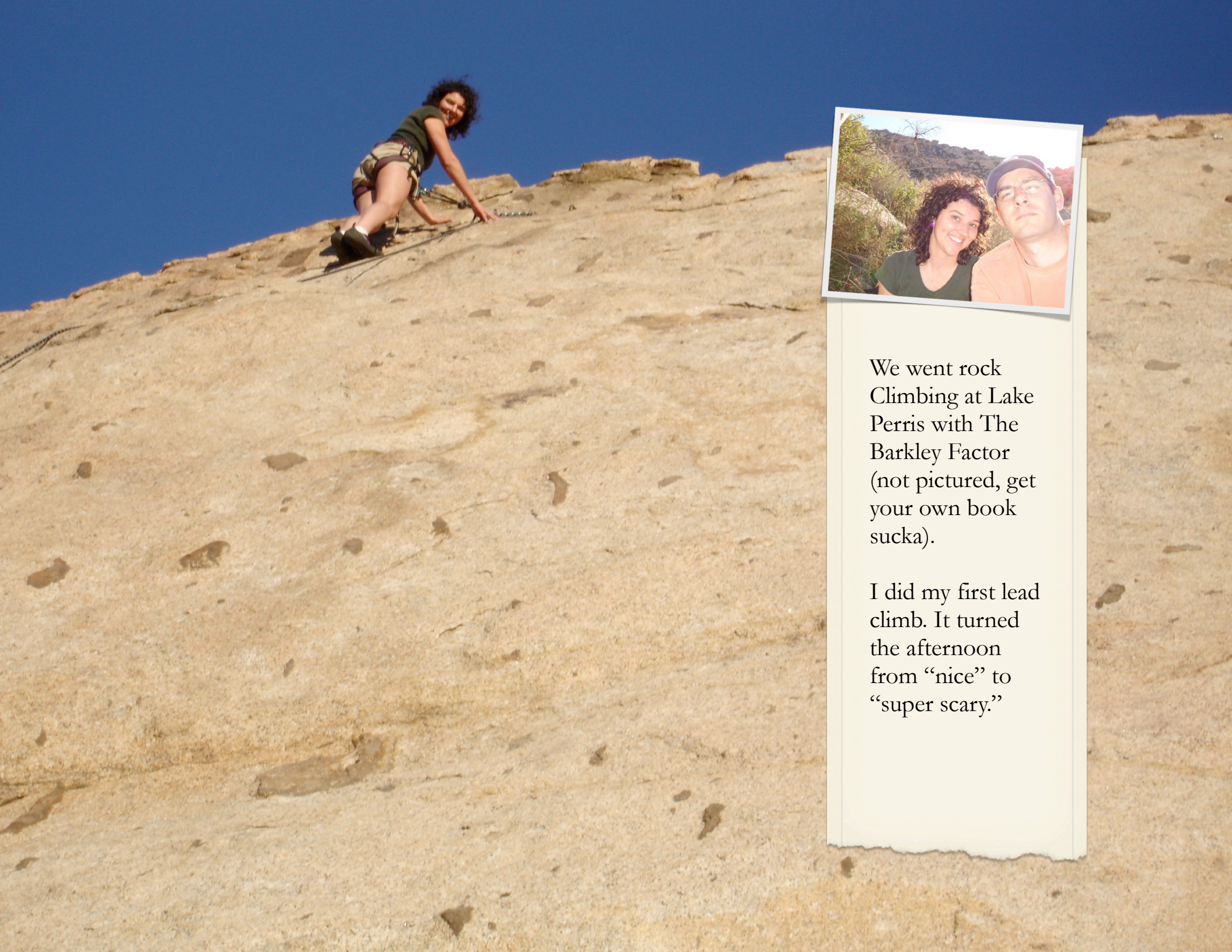

“super scary.”



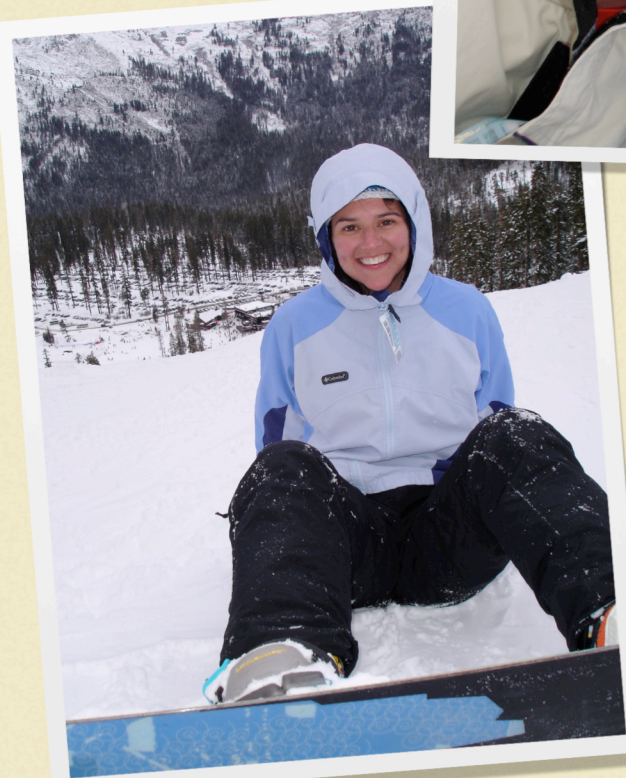
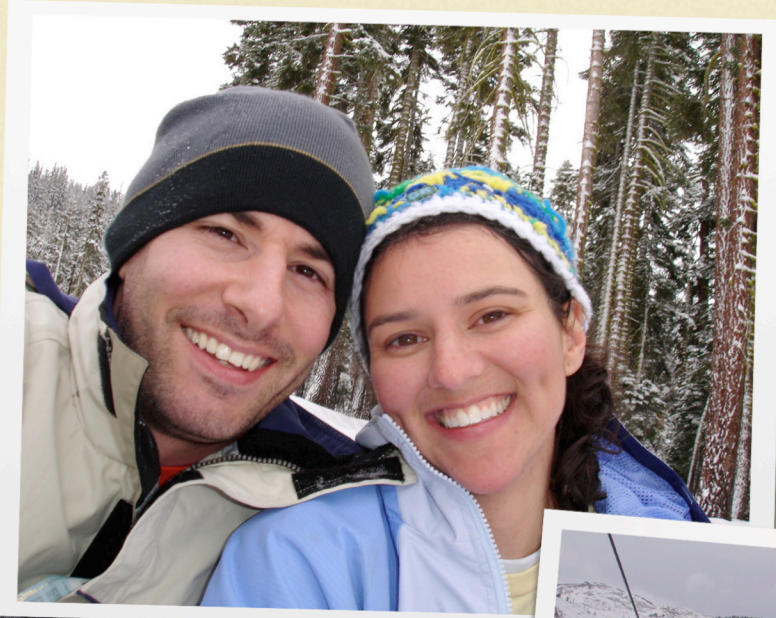

Dance Dance, Guru Guru, and helping me document Chaz's hat collection.



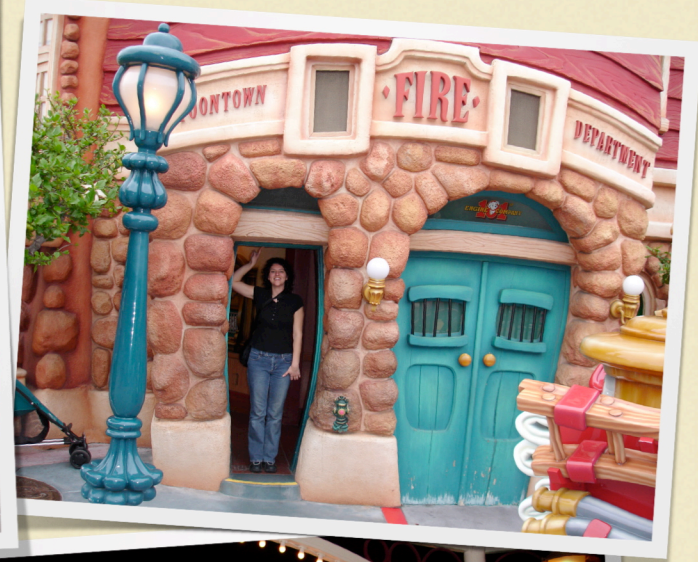
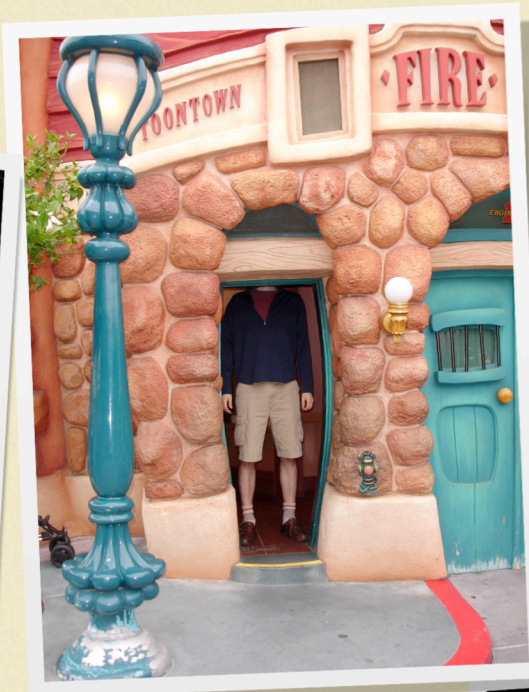
I insisted we eat at a restaurant with the same word repeated twice in the name. My companions thought I was being unreasonable until... Guru Guru!

I got a mohawk and she still went out with me in public. We had sushi and then went to the Zoo.

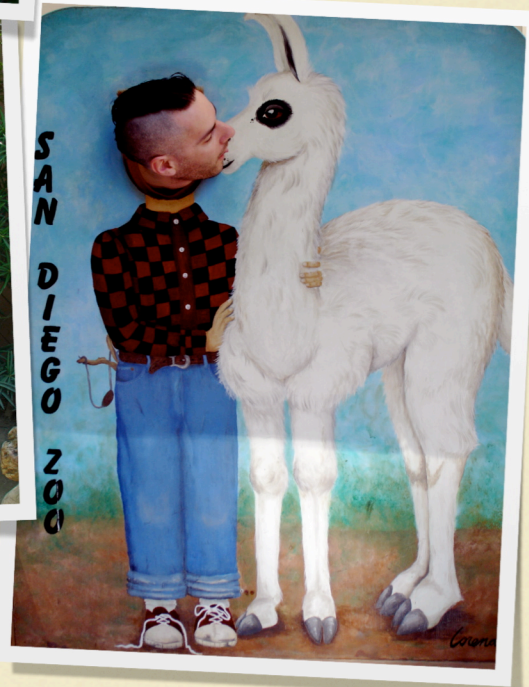




Fun fact #1: Holly is afraid of goats.

on the far right.

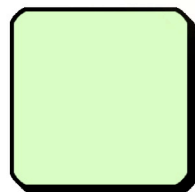




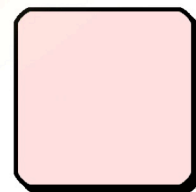
